Entrepreneur	(특히 모험적인) 사업가, 기업가	He's an entrepreneur / I really admire entrepreneurs / she has the entrepreneurial spirit	An entrepreneur is a person who starts and runs a business.
Fussy	까다로운	she's very fussy about her clothes / He's very fussy about what he eats /	This is a very commonly used word to describe someone who is extremely sensitive to the way something is or should be.
Go pear shaped	(일이) 잘못되다	Oh dear, I think this is going pear shaped / this programme has gone pear shaped	Means - something has gone wrong and is probably out of control.
Retrospective	회고하는 소급 적용되는 (어떤 법이나 조치의 영향력이 과거까지 거슬러 올라가 미치게 되는)	We need to look at this retrospectively / This is a retrospective law	The word "retrospective means 'looking back. When it comes to law, retrospective means the law will effect the past too.
Steal one's thunder	(남의 생각이나 아이디어를) 앞서서 가로채다	If we announce our new product now we'll steel our competitor's thunder / Our competitors have stolen our thunder	This does not mean 'stealing' someone's ideas. It really means being the first to do something when others are also trying to be the first.
Intuitive	이용하기 쉬운, 사용하기 쉬운	The way our service works is intuitive / This product is so intuitive / We need to make an intuitive product	Intuitive has become a fashionable word in recent years. It means that a product is easy to use. It is obvious.
Golf course / soccer pitch / basketball court / tennis / squash court		Often students use the word " field " to describe all sports areas. This is not always the case. We play soccer, rugby and hockey on a " pitch " and we play golf on a golf course .	Not all sports 'fields' are called 'field' For example it is not a 'golf field' it is a 'golf course'
